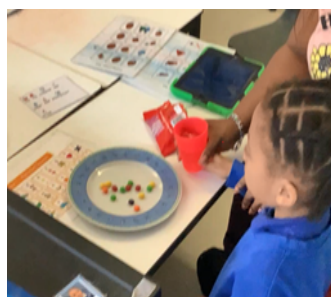
Blue Class

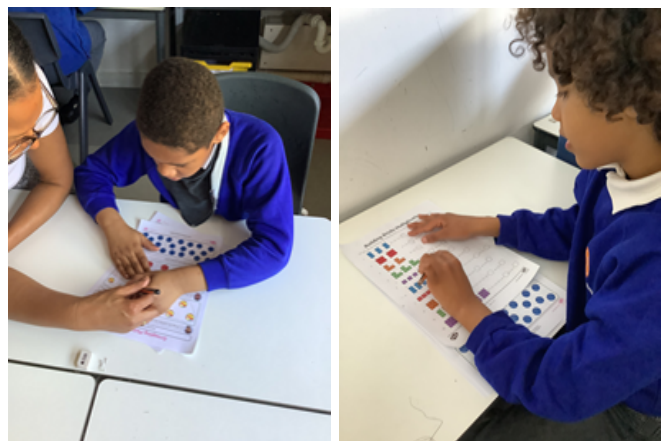
Silver Class
