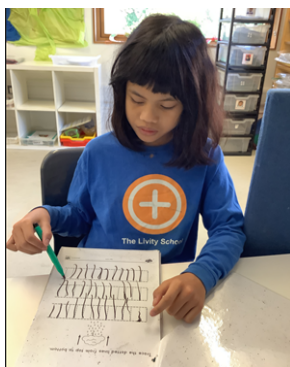
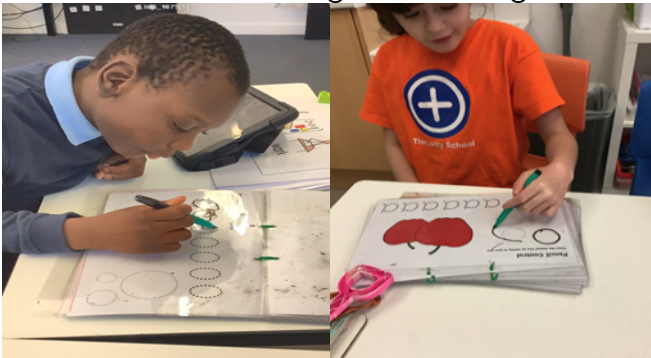
Gold Class
