Red Class

Red Class participated in an interactive workshop about the 'Jonkonnu Masquerade' at the Black Cultural Archives. We listened to music, created artwork and took part in our own masquerade.



Yellow Class

Yellow Class children this week, have been doing activities related to the "Earth Day". They created a farm sensory bin with different materials and explored them together. They also recreated the Ocean and helped to clean it picking cardboard and plastic from it. The children also enjoyed a sensory cooking lesson where they made breakfast pots.



Pink Class

In Pink Class this week we've linked our story, 'The Tale of Mr Jeremy Fisher', to our How My World Works sessions on habitats. We have been investigating what animals and plants live in ponds and have taken this an opportunity for lots of water play out on the Pink Class terrace. We've also had a visit from the Speech and Language team this week

who helped teach us about strategies for selfregulation.



Blue Class

This week Blue Class enjoyed the Sciences Lesson as part of *How my World Works*. They learned how to do foam mixing bicarbonate and vinegar. Well done Blue Class.



Orange Class

In Orange Class this week, we have been learning about English currency. We started by introducing coins and children have been familiarising themselves with them and starting to recognise them. Pupils showed a great enthusiasm during the activities that followed

and engaged very well with the resources provided.

Ladybird Class

This week Ladybirds Class have enjoyed carrying out an experiment called: 'Rain in a cloud jar'. They have used water and shaving foam to make a cloud. Then, they have made rain drops with the use of pipettes and blue food colouring. The children have also enjoyed exploring the texture of saltdough by cutting out various shapes to make hanging decorations.

Ladybirds have had fun driving cars through the paint and onto the paper to observe what patterns the wheels make. They have been learning about shapes by matching different object to their 2D shapes.





Rainbow Class

This week in Rainbow Class, we enjoyed being active while practising our gross motor skills. We were throwing colourful quoits onto their matching hoops and seeing who could throw all their quoits the fastest! Once we had thrown them all on, we went to collect them and did it all again! We really had a lot of fun doing it.
