Red Class

Red Class have been working hard in their messy play sessions, exploring resources independently. We have made beautiful decorations for our classroom. The pupils are working hard to maintain and develop their skills as part of their 'MOVE' goals.



Pink Class

In Pink Class this week, the pupils were able to count one to twenty using objects to support counting. During our story session all the children were excited to read a book and were able to say what they could see in the pictures. The children have settled in well.



Yellow Class

We've had a busy week in Yellow Class. In our 'How My World Works' sessions we've been learning about lifecycles. We have welcomed five caterpillars into class which we hope to raise to be butterflies. In cooking, we've been following recipes and instructions whilst making fruit smoothies. The pupils explored a large variety of fruits which they then blended with apple juice. Delicious!



Blue Class

Blue Class have been busy with a variety of activities and learning covering all areas of our curriculum. The children have done some wonderful art which will soon decorate our classroom. The pupils have also been exploring the textures of various substances, ranging from soft to hard and deciding on their favourite.





Orange Class

In Orange Class this week, our phonics and cooking sessions went very well. In phonics, we have been learning about the sounds a, l, m, s, and t. During our cooking session we made porridge and the children had lots of fun mixing the ingredients and tasting them.



Ladybird Class

This week Ladybird Class have been actively engaging in different types of activities. They have been developing their attention as well as turn taking during their Attention Bucket sessions. They have also been building up their fine motor skills; they filled buckets with soil and then squeezed on whipping cream to make pretend raspberry ice cream. The children have had a lot of fun dressing up and dancing to disco music during the Whippersnappers session.



Dragonfly Class

Dragonfly children this week, explored our new sensory board of different materials. The children also enjoyed our cooking lesson where they made chocolate mousse and mixed it with other ingredients to create new textures. They also participated in a new sensory story called 'The Autumn Forest' where they chose their favourite props to use.



Rainbow Class

Rainbow Classes new children have settled into the new experience well. Everyone has helped them with writing, exploring sensory play and reading.



Green Class

This week Green Class have been enjoying using switches in a variety of ways. Green Class have shown great realisation when using the switches to operate games and toys. Some children have been experimenting by using different parts of their bodies to operate the switches in different ways.



Purple Class

This week, Purple Class continued to actively engage with the story 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' using their senses and lots of fine and gross motor movement. The pupils looked for minibeasts in the sensory garden and manipulated various natural materials. Purple Class also made smoothies and explored different fruit using their senses.



Butterfly Class

This week in Butterfly Class the children have engaged in some activities for our mental well-being week. We have used the body scan as part of our mindfulness activities. We did a dress up activity within our massage story and produced some free art pieces with collage materials and paint. We ended the week with a disco joining our friends in Dragonfly Class.



Bumblebee Class

This week Bumblebee Class enjoyed making biscuits. We also practised our gross motor skills in P.E. and we had fun creating pictures with string and different coloured paint to create our own art.



Gold Class

Gold Class are working on solving additions and subtractions using Numicon shapes. The

pupils are becoming more independent in sequencing number sentences and matching numbers. This week the pupils have shredded red cabbage and followed the steps to complete an experiment. We used different tools to decorate the classroom with gold paint.



Silver Class

This week the Silver Class children learnt how to take turns when interacting with one another during play time. Also, during our phonics session, Silver Class focused on how to sound a-e words and split digraphs. The children were presented with photos of some a-e sounds in order for them to spell it out.

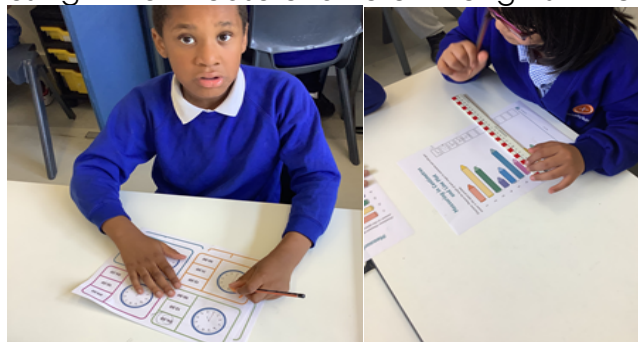


Unicorn Class
