#### **Red Class**

Red Class went on an exciting trip into London on the train this week. The pupils enjoyed the multisensory experiences of being in a busy station, walking to St James' and Green Park and visiting Buckingham Palace.



#### **Yellow Class**

Yellow Class children this week, enjoyed their sensory engagement sessions, which were based on light and movement. They explored sensory resources following the rhythm of the music and shared them in small groups. The children continued practising their physiotherapy programs with new postures added to the floor sessions. They have also started to make decorations to celebrate our International Day at school.



#### **Pink Class**

This week in Pink Class we've been creating some large-scale art. We put blue paint on to a big sheet of paper and walked along it barefoot to create a 'river', as part of our learning on the rainforest. In cooking this week, we made coconut and pineapple smoothies which tasted delicious.



#### **Blue Class**

This week Blue Class enjoyed and engaged in a 3D shapes lesson. They carried on the activity during the art lesson, they painted using coloured materials and a variety of different mark making tools.



#### **Orange Class**

In Orange Class this week, the pupils enjoyed our 'How my World Works' lesson. They engaged in making volcanoes using bicarbonate of soda, coca cola or alternatively lemon, food colouring and bicarbonate of soda. They loved creating and watching the reactions.



#### **Ladybird Class**

This week Ladybird Class have enjoyed taking part in different outdoor activities. They have been practising their balancing skills on the equipment in the playground. Ladybirds have also explored quantity by filling and emptying containers during water play outside. The children have been developing their fine motor skills by colouring in flags for the International Day. They have also placed tree branches inside the honey bee tree.



**Rainbow Class** 

In Rainbow Class this term, we have been learning about how our bodies work in science. This week we have been focusing on the digestive system and how our bodies process food.



### **Green Class**

This week in Green Class we have enjoyed creating our own scented playdough. We followed the instructions to make the dough and chose what scent we wanted to use. We then used the dough to practise our fine motor skills. We have also enjoyed making potato and carrot soup this week.



#### **Butterfly Class**

This week we made our second visit to Brockwell Park. We toured the garden and saw so many plants and herbs. We also found some snails and mini-beasts. The whole class enjoyed the trip!



### **Bumblebee Class**

This week we had fun in our cooking lesson, making flapjacks and following all the recipe steps. Then, we tasted them at snack! We have been practising our communication skills by choosing our favourite toys from a choosing board. In our literacy session, Bumblebees have been super engaged in our sensory story and were curious to touch and feel the different objects that represent the story.






#### **Gold Class**
