Yellow Class

In Yellow Class this week, some of our pupils have been exploring sensory trays linked to our story 'Leaf Man'. The pupils were able to investigate a range of different textures, colours and smells all linked to Autumn. In cooking we made bagel pizzas. We grated our own cheese and chopped our toppings before putting them in the oven. We thought they were delicious when we ate them at snack time!



Pink Class

In Pink Class, we conducted a fun experiment with skittles, creating a colourful rainbow right before our eyes! The children were fascinated to see the skittles change when they added warm water, watching the colours dissolve and swirl across the plate. It was a hands-on learning experience full of excitement and discovery!





Blue Class

This week we recreated our favourite scenes from our story 'Going on a Bear Hunt'. We explored thick oozy mud, snow swirling and whirling, the deep dark forest and the deep cold river.' We also learnt new sound phonemes and how to correctly form the letter name or grapheme. We also enjoyed the recreation of the northern lights from our Winter sensory story performers.



Orange Class

This week Orange Class have been exploring whether items will float or sink in water. We tested a range of objects and then sorted them according to the results. Orange Class have also enjoyed making fairy cakes. We added different flavours of our choosing and then choose which mix we wanted in our cake cases. Vanilla and chocolate were the most popular.



Ladybird Class

This week Ladybird Class have enjoyed exploring Christmas season resources whilst participating in a drama game workshop. They have enjoyed working in a group whilst making spiky caterpillars. They have also practised turn taking by playing games and sharing a toy with a friend. Ladybirds have also focused on learning and recognising their emotions. The children have been developing their fine motor skills through colour sorting activities.



Dragonfly Class

This week, Dragonfly children enjoyed their Intensive Interaction sessions in different positions. They also participated in a sensory show performed by the Embracing Arts team. The children actively participated by using the props and vocalising during the story.

This week Bumblebee Class had a drama workshop. It had a Winter theme and involved our different senses. We enjoyed the music and exploring the different materials and textures.




Gold Class

Silver Class

This week in Silver Class, the children participated in activities that focus on preventing bullying, showing respect, and celebrating differences. They learnt how to use kind words to help others feel good about themselves. The children are also discovering how to stay safe, be kind, and understand that they are special. Additionally, they are practising sharing, using kind hands, listening well, and taking turns.
