Red Class

Red Class have been working hard in 'My Communication', participating in Intensive Interaction with the adults in their class. In 'My Cognition', pupils are affecting their environment using A frames and the Little Room.



Yellow Class

Yellow Class children this week, explored Summer fruits during their sensory engagement sessions. They played with the watermelon's texture and the pineapple's smell. They enjoyed squishing the oranges and reacted to them with movement and vocalisations. The children also enjoyed small group sessions on the mats where they shared toys with sounds and UV lights.



Pink Class

This week Pink Class walked to the Hillside Gardens Park. The pupils all had a great time interacting with the different play equipment at the park. In our music session this week we had lots of fun using a microphone plugged into an effects box to put different sounds on our voices.



Blue Class

The pupils in Blue Class have been very focused on their individual work box tasks this week. They have also enjoyed practising their fine motor skills. The pupils covered plastic wallets in oil and Vaseline. They then dropped paint on to the plastic using a dropper and moved the paint using a writing tool.



Orange Class

In Orange Class this week, the children have been working hard on their phonics skills. They have also been practising their fine motor skills and this is clear to see in their improved letter formation and handwriting. We have also enjoyed making and manipulating playdough in different colours.



Ladybird Class

This week Ladybird Class have been filling and emptying pots and pans with dry and wet porridge. They have also been exploring the texture of cornflour as a shared activity. Some children have been working in pairs to complete puzzles. Ladybirds have been practising their phonics skills by building CVC words. The pupils have been developing their fine motor skills by placing pancake mixture onto a cold pan.



Rainbow Class

In Rainbow Class this week, we have been busy consolidating our knowledge of the unit 5 sounds in phonics. We also enjoyed cooking a meal to take home on Tuesday. We made pasta in tomato and basil sauce which was delicious! We followed the instructions carefully to make sure we made a very tasty sauce.



Green Class

This week in Green Class we have been enjoying our sensory engagement sessions about Summer. We have loved smelling and touching flowers and creating bird sounds using a special whistle. Our favourite activity this week has been making vegetable soup. We cut and squashed all the ingredients and then used a switch to cook them in a soup machine.







Purple Class

This week in Purple Class, we enjoyed a trip to the Horniman Museum and Gardens. This term we are learning all about 'Living Things'. We visited the aquarium where we saw a range of different, colourful fish. We went for a walk around the gardens, where we used our senses to explore the plants there. We also had a workshop about where different animals live around the world! It was lots of fun.





Butterfly Class

This week in Butterfly Class we have been on a trip to the greenhouses at Brockwell Park. Whilst we were there we explored the gardens and found runner beans. We had a go at pulling the beans out and washed the herbs from the garden. We had a great day!



Bumblebee Class

This week we have had fun creating a red hen using a paper plate, googly eyes and red paint to link to our story 'The Little Red Hen'. We also enjoyed practising our fine motor skills using coloured linking chains.



Gold Class

This week, Gold Class worked on activities related to our story, 'The Tale of Jeremy Fisher'. The pupils read words from the story and matched them with their character pictures. We created a dessert for Mr Jeremy Fisher's dinner with his friends. We made sticky mud and wiggly worm cups, with crushed chocolate biscuits and strawberry laces with milk. The pupils read and sequenced the recipe and matched the visuals to the ingredients to make requests.



Silver Class

In our phonics lessons this week we have been focusing on the 'ff' sound. The pupils enjoyed investigating the different resources that have this sound. Other groups focused on spelling. In 'How my World Works' we created sensory food play. The idea is to encourage children to explore fruit and vegetables. The children were encouraged to see, touch and smell the ingredients. They also liked listening to the sounds that were made when they cut the fruit and vegetables, but mostly they liked tasting them.



Unicorn Class

This week in Unicorn Class we have been role playing different characters to improve our communication skills. We have also been using the computer to create PowerPoints. We delivered instructions to our peers with the use of ICT.
